It meets monthly at the SCAQMD offices in Diamond Bar.
<b>REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION AGENCIES CONSORTIUM</b>	Robin Lowe Vacant, Alt	The Consortium was established by the AB 1246 process and is comprised of County Transportation Commissions, Caltrans, and SCAG. It advises the Regional Council regarding transportation matters, specifically on multi-county and inter-county conflict issues. It meets on an annual basis at the SCAG offices.
<b>SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS- REGIONAL COUNCIL</b>	Robin Lowe	The Regional Council conducts the affairs of SCAG; implements the General Assembly's policy decisions; acts upon policy recommendations from SCAG policy committees and external agencies; appoints committees to study specific problems and programs; and amends, decreases or increases the proposed budget to be reported to the General Assembly. It meets monthly on the first Thursday in Los Angeles.
<b>SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS- TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE</b>	Robin Lowe	The Committee studies problems, programs and other matters that pertain to the regional issues of mobility, air quality, transportation control measures and communications, and makes recommendations on such matters to the Regional Council. It meets monthly on the first Thursday at Noon in Los Angeles.
