It meets monthly on the first Thursday in Los Angeles.</p> <p>The Transportation Committee studies problems, programs and other matters that pertain to the regional issues of mobility, air quality, transportation control measures and communications, and makes recommendations on such matters to the Regional Council. It meets monthly on the first Thursday at Noon in Los Angeles.</p> <p>The Coalition was established by the AB 1246 process and is comprised of County Transportation Commissions, Caltrans, and SCAG. It advises the Regional Council regarding transportation matters, specifically on multi-county and inter-county conflict issues. It meets on an annual basis at the SCAG offices.</p>
