Section I – BACKGROUND

Section I. B Last Paragraph is revised as follows:

Section II - INSTRUCTIONS TO OFFERORS

A new Section II. M shall be added to read as follows:

M. DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (DBE)

As a grantee of specific federal funding sources, the Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) is required to establish a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program in accordance with the regulations of the United States Department of Transportation (DOT), Title 49 CFR Part 26.

Tasks associated with this project may be subject to Title 49 CFR Part 26, entitled "Participation by Disadvantaged Business Enterprises in Department of Transportation Financial Assistance Programs ("Regulations"). The Regulations have been adopted by the Commission, and are hereby incorporated in their entirety by this reference. Offerors are to be fully informed respecting the DBE requirements, the Regulations.

RCTC may utilize Federal Transit Administration (FTA) funds in this work and is, therefore, complying with FTA policy in this procurement. RCTC has calculated and established a project specific race neutral DBE goal of 14.61% that RCTC desires to achieve for the Project described in this RFQ. RCTC encourages Offerors to assist RCTC in meeting or exceeding this goal by soliciting DBE firms for participation on the Project; however, utilization of DBE firms is not part of the RFQ selection criteria. Whether or not Offeror intends to offer DBE utilization, all Offerors must complete the DBE Bidder's List included under Exhibit "D" to the RFQ, and the Local Agency DBE Information form attached to this Addendum No. 1 (and also included as an exhibit to the Model Agreement). Please review Exhibit "G" of the Model Agreement for further information regarding DBE participation. Including the commercially useful function requirement.

Section III – MODEL AGREEMENT

The Model Agreement, attached to the RFQ as Exhibit "B", is hereby amended as follows:

1. The second sentence of first paragraph of Exhibit "G" to the Model Agreement is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

The Commission's race-neutral DBE goal for the Project described in this Agreement is 14.61%.

2. The first sentence of Section 5 of Exhibit "G" to the Model Agreement is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

As stated above, the Commission's race-neutral DBE goal for the Project described in this Agreement is 14.61%.

3. Pages I-3, I-4, I-5 and I-6 of Exhibit "I" to the Model Agreement are hereby deleted in their entirety.
