

Northbound I-15 Lane Closures: Two lanes on northbound I-15 will be closed Friday, January 28 at 9 p.m. to Saturday, January 29 at 9 a.m. for crews to safely pour concrete for new bridge segments.

The northbound #1 lane, hook off-ramp, and on-ramp will remain open. Motorists may continue on northbound I-15 using the #1 lane or exit at Railroad Canyon Rd., turn left onto Grape St., left onto Railroad Canyon Rd., and right onto the northbound I-15 on-ramp.

Alternating lane closures are also scheduled Friday, January 28 from 10 p.m. to 2 a.m., on eastbound and westbound Railroad Canyon Rd.


Drive safely, expect delays, and allow for extra travel time. Please follow the posted detour signs.

Northbound I-15 detour

- Exit northbound I-15 Railroad Canyon Rd. hook off-ramp
- Turn left onto north Grape St. towards Railroad Canyon Rd.
- Turn left onto west Railroad Canyon Rd.
- Turn right onto northbound I-15 on-ramp

Motorists also may continue on northbound I-15 using the #1 lane. Please reduce speeds in our construction zone.

Project Background

The Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC), in partnership with Caltrans and the City of Lake Elsinore, is upgrading the Interstate 15 Railroad Canyon Interchange in Lake Elsinore. RCTC is the lead agency for this project.

The project will improve safety and capacity by adding lanes, modifying ramps, and building sidewalks and bike lanes along Railroad Canyon Road. These improvements will help residents and other travelers move through this area and reach businesses and other "Dream Extreme" attractions in Lake Elsinore.

Please expect periodic closures to lanes and ramps, slow down, allow extra travel time, watch for construction crews and equipment, be alert to changing conditions, follow detours, and stay informed by checking construction updates, social media, and mapping apps.
