**Construction Update:
Week of July 12, 2021**



Northbound lanes and ramps will be closed Monday or Tuesday night to prepare for the new northbound hook off-ramp opening. The new ramp is expected to open Tuesday morning, July 13. Lane closures also are planned for utility work on local streets.

Monday, July 12	8 p.m. – 4 a.m. 9 p.m. – 5 a.m.	Closure of two northbound I-15 lanes and northbound I-15 on- and off-ramps at Railroad Canyon Rd. Intermittent lane closures on westbound Railroad Canyon Rd., northbound Summerhill Dr. and the eastbound Railroad Canyon Rd. inside left turn lane.
Tuesday, July 13	8 p.m. – 4 a.m.	If needed: Closure of two northbound I-15 lanes and northbound I-15 on- and off-ramps at Railroad Canyon Rd.
Thursday and Friday, July 15 and 16	Daily, 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. Nightly, 9 p.m. – 5 a.m.	Alternating lane closures on northbound and southbound Grape St. Intermittent lane closures on southbound Grape St. and eastbound Railroad Canyon Rd.

Project Progress

Crews are excavating and drilling ground anchors for a new retaining wall.



Project Background

The Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC), in partnership with Caltrans and the City of Lake Elsinore, is upgrading the Interstate 15 Railroad Canyon Interchange in Lake Elsinore. RCTC is the lead agency for this project.

The project will improve safety and capacity by adding lanes, modifying ramps, and building sidewalks and bike lanes along Railroad Canyon Road. These improvements will help residents and other travelers move through this area and reach businesses and other “Dream Extreme” attractions in Lake Elsinore.

Please expect periodic closures to lanes and ramps, slow down, allow extra travel time, watch for construction crews and equipment, be alert to changing conditions, follow detours, and stay informed by checking construction updates, social media, and mapping apps.
