Construction Update:
Week of August 30, 2021



Railroad Canyon Rd. will be fully closed Monday night for crews to restripe between the I-15 ramps. The southbound I-15 off-ramp left-turn lanes and the full northbound on-ramp will be closed Monday night as well. Tuesday through Thursday, there will be nightly lane closures on northbound I-15 to place k-rail.

The restriping on Monday night will result in a lane shift for motorists heading through the intersection of Railroad Canyon Rd. at I-15. Please stay alert and follow the new striping and posted signs.

No closures are planned Friday, September 3 – Monday, September 6 for the Labor Day weekend.

Monday, August 30	8 p.m. – 5 a.m.	Railroad Canyon Rd. closed between the I-15 ramps. See detour below. Southbound I-15 off-ramp left turn lanes close Northbound I-15 off-ramp closed.
Tuesday, August 31 – Thursday, September 2	8 p.m. – 4 a.m.	Two lanes closed on northbound I-15

For **westbound** Railroad Canyon Rd. take Canyon Estates Dr., Camino Del Norte, Main St., I-15 south to Railroad Canyon Rd.

For **eastbound** Railroad Canyon Rd. take I-15 south, Bundy Canyon Dr., I-15 north to Railroad Canyon Rd.








Project Background

The Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC), in partnership with Caltrans and the City of Lake Elsinore, is upgrading the Interstate 15 Railroad Canyon Interchange in Lake Elsinore. RCTC is the lead agency for this project.

The project will improve safety and capacity by adding lanes, modifying ramps, and building sidewalks and bike lanes along Railroad Canyon Road. These improvements will help residents and other travelers move through this area and reach businesses and other “Dream Extreme” attractions in Lake Elsinore.

Please expect periodic closures to lanes and ramps, slow down, allow extra travel time, watch for construction crews and equipment, be alert to changing conditions, follow detours, and stay informed by checking construction updates, social media, and mapping apps.
