**Construction Update:  
Week of November 16, 2020**



There will be daily intermittent lane closures on Railroad Canyon Rd. and Diamond Dr. for utility work, Monday through Thursday. On Thursday night, intermittent lane closures will occur on southbound I-15.

**Reminder:** The Interstate 15 southbound off-ramp at Railroad Canyon Rd. will be fully closed from **Friday, November 13 at 9 p.m. to Monday, November 16 at 4 a.m.** Traffic signals also will be set on “flash.” Please use Bundy Canyon Road as an alternate off-ramp and allow extra travel time through this area. Please remember to patronize local businesses during this weekend closure.

Date	Time	Closure Details
Monday – Thursday November 16-19	Daily, 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.	Intermittent lane closures on Railroad Canyon Rd. and Diamond Dr. Streets will remain open to through-traffic.
Thursday, November 19	8 p.m. – 4 a.m.	Intermittent lane closures on southbound I-15. At least one lane will remain open.

**Project Progress**

## Project Background

The Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC), in partnership with Caltrans and the City of Lake Elsinore, is upgrading the Interstate 15 Railroad Canyon Interchange in Lake Elsinore. RCTC is the lead agency for this project.

The project will improve safety and capacity by adding lanes, modifying ramps, and building sidewalks and bike lanes along Railroad Canyon Road. These improvements will help residents and other travelers move through this area and reach businesses and other “Dream Extreme” attractions in Lake Elsinore.

Please expect periodic closures to lanes and ramps, slow down, allow extra travel time, watch for construction crews and equipment, be alert to changing conditions, follow detours, and stay informed by checking construction updates, social media, and mapping apps.
