Join RCTC on February 6 to Learn about Proposed Riverside-Downtown Station Improvements

Changes may be coming to the Riverside-Downtown Station, which will allow more efficient Metrolink service and improve the experience for train riders.

The Riverside County Transportation Commission, which owns and operates the station, and Metrolink propose adding another passenger loading platform and tracks, extending the pedestrian bridge, expanding parking and enhancing pedestrian access to the station.
