



Riverside-Downtown STATION IMPROVEMENTS

OVERVIEW:

The Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) and Metrolink propose building an additional passenger loading platform and tracks to improve Metrolink service and extend the existing pedestrian bridge to have additional elevator and stair access. The proposed track would connect into the existing station layover tracks on the south side. The Project would also provide parking and improve traffic flow on the south side of the station. These improvements would improve Metrolink train connections without affecting BNSF service.

The proposed Project includes:

- Building a new 720-foot center platform
- Constructing new tracks and making other track improvements
- Modifying the railroad signal system
- Extending the pedestrian bridge, including elevator and ADA access
- Relocating ADA parking
- Adding parking to the south side of station
- Building a new pedestrian at-grade rail crossing
- Modifying the bus drop-off area
- Adding sidewalks
