



Free Railroad Safety School Presentations!

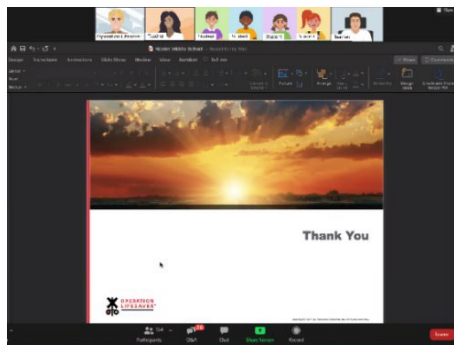
