

Week of July 20, 2025



As crews close out the northbound I-15 Rancho California Road direct on-ramp full closure, the I-15 Smart Freeway Pilot Project will require lane reductions of northbound I-15 as well as on-ramp closures of Rancho California Road. The closures are scheduled to begin on Saturday, July 19.

Please see closure details below. Construction activity and closures are subject to change due to inclement weather and other factors.



## **Neighboring Projects**

<u>I-15 Temecula Auxiliary Lanes Project:</u> The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is constructing auxiliary lanes, and implementing other transportation system upgrades between Temecula Parkway to just north of Winchester Road on I-15. ## **Project Background**

RCTC, in partnership with Caltrans, the City of Temecula, and the Western Riverside Council of Governments, will be implementing an innovative technology along the northbound Interstate 15 (I-15) in Temecula and Murrieta that is anticipated to improve traffic operations.

The I-15 Smart Freeway Pilot Project will use "smart" technology to continuously monitor real-time traffic conditions along northbound I-15 in Temecula. This section of northbound I-15 encounters high traffic congestion from cars entering the Temecula Parkway, Rancho California Road, and Winchester Road on-ramps during peak afternoon and evening hours. The coordinated system will improve traffic flow by adjusting the optimal number of vehicles to enter and efficiently travel on the I-15.





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
