



Riverside-Downtown STATION IMPROVEMENTS

OVERVIEW:

The Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) and the Southern California Regional Rail Authority (Metrolink), in collaboration with the Federal Transit Administration (FTA), propose to improve the Riverside-Downtown Station.

Increasing freight train service causes delays to Metrolink service at the Riverside-Downtown Station. Station improvements are needed to avoid conflicts with freight train traffic, reduce delays, and allow for future Metrolink service expansion. The purpose of the project is to expand platform capacity, and improve operations, efficiency, connectivity, and the passenger experience at the station.

The proposed project includes:

- Building a new platform
- Constructing new tracks and making other track improvements
- Modifying the railroad signal system
- Extending the pedestrian bridge, including elevator and ADA access
- Relocating ADA parking
- Adding parking to the south side of station
- Modifying the bus drop-off area
- Adding sidewalks
