Daytime Closures Set for Route 60, April 16, 18-20 for Roadway Paving

Daytime full and partial closures of westbound and eastbound Route 60 in the Badlands between Moreno Valley and Beaumont will start Saturday, April 16 and continue Monday-Wednesday, April 18-20, for paving of the Riverside County Transportation Commission's Route 60 Truck Lanes Project.

The closures will allow crews to safely pave the roadway at the east and west ends of the project. Paving must be completed during warmer daytime hours for the asphalt to dry properly. Work was scheduled to reduce the impact on Easter and Passover travelers and on Coachella Festival attendees.

Westbound Route 60 will be fully closed Saturday, April 16 from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Motorists should avoid the area, if possible, allow extra travel time and use I-10 as an alternate route.

Single lane closures are scheduled on eastbound Route 60:

- Monday, April 18, from 6 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Tuesday, April 19, from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Wednesday, April 20, from 6 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Work is subject to change, based on weather, staffing, and material availability.
