

# Construction Update: Week of May 16, 2022

There will be lane, ramp and connector closures the week of May 16 as crews near completion of the Route 60 Truck Lanes. Please drive safely and watch for announcements for the opening of the new lanes – coming soon!

### **Roadway and Connector Closures**

Westbound Route 60 will be fully closed nightly, Monday, May 16 to Wednesday, May 18, from 10 p.m. – 5 a.m. See the detour map below. The eastbound and westbound Interstate 10 connectors to westbound Route 60 will be closed during this time as well. Please use I-10 as an alternate route.



The Route 60 eastbound on-ramp at Gilman Springs Rd and one Route 60 eastbound lane will also be closed nightly, Monday to Wednesday from 9 p.m. – 6 a.m.

These closures are needed for crews to continue to safely restripe lanes.

### Weekly Drone Video

### **Project Background**

The 60 Truck Lanes Project is widening a 4.5-mile section of Route 60 between Gilman Springs Road and 1.4 miles west of Jack Rabbit Trail through Riverside County's Badlands between Moreno Valley and Beaumont. The project lies within mountainous terrain with a curving alignment and steep grades. The project is designed to improve safety and reduce traffic congestion. The new lanes are expected to open in summer 2022.

**The City of Moreno Valley's Moreno Beach Bridge Project:** The city is replacing the two-lane bridge with a seven-lane bridge and building a dedicated on-ramp from southbound Moreno Beach Drive to westbound Route 60. Learn more: <u>morenobeachproject.com</u>
