Nightly lane, connector, and ramp closures are planned **July 30 and August 1-5** for construction of the 91 Refresh project. See details below and plan ahead for multiple closures on Saturday, July 30 and daytime lane reductions on the Main Street on-ramp.

Please note: construction activity requires consecutive ramp closures on westbound 91 between Main St. and Lincoln Ave for demolition work. Construction activity may be noisy.



Lane Reductions, Second Street


For the safety of the crews and drivers, intermittent lane closures will occur on westbound Second St., between Sheridan St. and W. Grand Blvd., during weekday, daytime hours for sound wall reconstruction. Flaggers also will help motorists travel through the area.



Reconstruction of Westbound 91 Sound Wall along Bollero Place

Crews began demolishing and rebuilding portions of the westbound 91 sound wall along Bollero PI., between W. Grand Blvd. and N. Vicentia Ave. Work is scheduled during daytime and nighttime hours.

For the safety of the crews and motorists, intermittent lane closures will occur on Bollero Pl., between Merrill St. and N. Vicentia Ave. Flaggers also will help motorists travel through the area. Parking on Bollero Pl. may be restricted during construction work.



Please note that construction activity is subject to change.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Riverside County Transportation Commission, in partnership with Caltrans, is starting delivering the 91 Refresh Project. This project will repave lanes and make repairs to sound walls and associated concrete barriers along the outer portions of eastbound and westbound 91 in Corona. Work will take place along the 91, mainly between the Lincoln Avenue Interchange and Interstate 15, an area with a long history of roadway settlement due to the Temescal Wash. Temporary lane shifts, weekend full closures, and lane closures will allow crews to safely complete the repaving and repair work. The project is expected to be completed this fall.
