




SPECIAL ALERT EASTBOUND 91 LANES NOW OPEN IN CORONA



All Lanes on Eastbound 91 in Corona Reopen Ahead of Schedule

Our crews completed their work ahead of schedule, and all lanes on eastbound 91 in Corona are now **OPEN**, approximately 13 hours ahead of tomorrow's scheduled 5 a.m. opening.

The eastbound 91 lanes from Lincoln Avenue to Main Street were closed Friday, October 21 at 10 p.m. and through this afternoon for crews to safely repave lanes. The eastbound 91 Express Lanes and eastbound 91 on-ramps at Auto Center Drive/Serfas Club Drive, Maple Street, and Lincoln Avenue also have reopened early.

Crews are continuing to repave lanes to provide a smoother ride. The work was completed for the <u>91 Refresh Project</u>, a joint effort between RCTC and Caltrans.

We thank motorists and residents of this area for their understanding during this closure. We also appreciate our construction crews, who worked very hard all weekend to complete this work far ahead of schedule.



ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Riverside County Transportation Commission, in partnership with Caltrans, is delivering the 91 Refresh Project. This project will repave lanes and make repairs to sound walls and associated concrete barriers along the outer portions of eastbound and westbound 91 in Corona. Work will take place along the 91, mainly between the Lincoln Avenue Interchange and Interstate 15, an area with a long history of roadway settlement. Temporary lane shifts, weekend full closures, and lane closures will allow crews to safely complete the repaving and repair work. The project is expected to be completed this fall.


