




SPECIAL ALERT: WESTBOUND 91 LANES, CONNECTORS, AND MAIN STREET OFF-RAMP REOPEN IN CORONA



Our crews completed their work ahead of schedule, and the westbound 91 lanes, 15/91 connectors, and Main Street off-ramp in Corona all **reopened** this morning about 20 hours ahead of tomorrow's scheduled 4 a.m. opening. The westbound 91 Main Street on-ramp is expected to reopen this afternoon.

Thank you, residents, businesses, and motorists, for your understanding during this closure. We also appreciate our construction crews, who worked very hard during these past eight days to complete this work ahead of schedule.

RCTC anticipates one additional weekend closure and ongoing night closures to complete this project before the end of 2022, weather permitting.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Riverside County Transportation Commission, in partnership with Caltrans, is delivering the 91 Refresh Project. This project will repave lanes and make repairs to sound walls and associated concrete barriers along the outer portions of eastbound and westbound 91 in Corona. Work will take place along the 91, mainly between the Lincoln Avenue Interchange and Interstate 15, an area with a long history of roadway settlement. Temporary lane shifts, weekend full closures, and lane closures will allow crews to safely complete the repaving and repair work. The project is expected to be completed this fall.
