

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE





Alternating lane closures, connector closures, and Express Lanes closures on eastbound and westbound 91 and northbound and southbound 71 are scheduled for the week of May 27, 2024. There will be no closures on Monday in observance of Memorial Day.

RCTC Traffic Relief Plan



Approved by the Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) on April 10, 2024, the Traffic Relief Plan outlines aspirational transportation solutions in Riverside County for Riverside County residents.

The updated Plan identifies the need to invest in crucial transportation projects, services, and infrastructure, including public transportation, roadway safety, highway improvements, active transportation, securing infrastructure from natural disasters, and environmental mitigation.
