Extended Ramp Closure

August 14 - August 25, 2025

The Riverside County Transportation Commission's I-15 Smart Freeway Pilot Project will require an extended **full closure** of the Rancho California Road loop on-ramp for northbound I-15 in Temecula. The loop on-ramp will close **beginning on Thursday, August 14 at 9 p.m. through Monday, August 25 at 5 a.m.**

The extended closure will allow crews to reconstruct the roadway and construct a concrete barrier on the Rancho California Road on-ramp. The on-ramp will be reconfigured and realigned to create a merge point between the Rancho California Road direct and loop on-ramp.


